

Symptoms of Heat Stroke in Dogs



Excessive prolonged or recurrent panting

Bright or dark red tongue and/or gums

Excessive thirst

Elevated temperature between 40-43°C

Sticky or dry tongue and or gums; thick saliva; may froth at mouth

Dogs staggers while walking or appears disoriented. Unwilling or unable to get up. Dog collapses and/or loses consciousness



Their heartbeat is much faster than normal

Vomiting and diarrhea
(may be bloody)
